- Use the relevant form to apply
- Supply images and information for inclusion in the guide and website by the deadline date of 29 February 2024
- Pay the relevant (non-refundable) fee in advance via BACS At the time of application and no later than March the 5th
Sort code 30-90-02 Account 01059689
 - a. 1/3 of a page entry at a cost of £108 [inclusive of VAT]
 - b. Full page entry at a cost of £234 [inclusive of VAT]
- Open and supervise the studio/exhibition space on the dates and times advertised.
- Ensure that directions to the studio/ exhibition space are prominently displayed
- Actively promote the event
- Each artist or group of artists will be expected to distribute at least one box of open studio guides [approx. 100 guides] in the run up to the event in the Crickhowell area and further afield
- Coordinate with other artists in the area, particularly with regards to leafleting & posting directional signage
- Conform to basic health and safety requirements in relation to access, materials and equipment.
- Arrange public liability insurance for the venue
- Return all signage which is the property of the Crickhowell Resource and Information Centre after the event
- Complete a feedback and evaluation form on the event
- Implement COVID-19 safety measures if recommended by Welsh government at the time of the event
